

- Previous Secretary resigned at Mission CONtrol. Election for replacement held.
 - Newly elected Secretary: Will Cromar (Yay, that's me)
- Policies and Procedures Committee: P&P will be split into a Policies and Procedures document and a Handbook.
 - P&P will contain only rules that will not change in the foreseeable future (eg age range).
 - Handbook will contain the *guidelines* for FLB level operations (eg elected officials' roles).
- Voted on Articles I, II, and III of Beacon Policies and Procedures, as appears in revision 8. (See attached document for P&P text)
 - Article I: passed
 - Article II: passed
 - Article III: passed
- Steering Council: In order to reinforce our position on our age range, individual Beacon groups should communicate with congregations to get signed letters of recommendation from each board. Once collected, these will be sent to proper district/regional authorities.
 - Alternatively, groups may seek petitions by hosting congregations.
 - Could be presented to congregations through services.
 - SC could also send out outreach packets, containing the following:
 - Letter written by SC
 - Petition supporting 12-20 age range
 - Beacon video
- Update from Vision Quest Convener: No significant progress since Mission CONtrol. Committee and Google+ Community recently put together. Plans to start meetings and planning for VQ in near future.
- (Discussion) Should be go forward with VQ?
 - General lack of support and interest
 - Invites may not have reached people who have not joined new mediums of communication
 - VQ business deferred to committee
